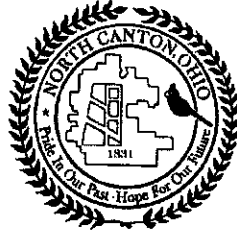

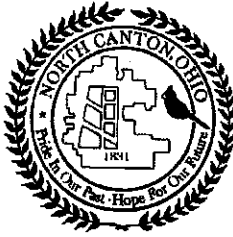

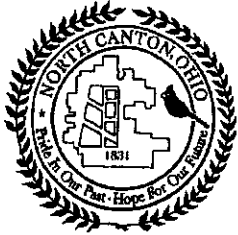

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, upon Board of Control approval, and pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, to enter into an agreement with Pfund Superior Sales Co. RE: **EVERHARD ROAD WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

A change order request has been submitted to the Board of Control for this project. This change order is due to the assignment of additional waterline replacement work to the Contractor along both Everhard Road (BellStore/Marathon east to Stratmoor) and Whipple Avenue (I-77 bridge to 140-feet north of Everhard). These additional areas were slated to be replaced in 2018/2019 as part of the Stark County Engineer's Whipple Avenue/Everhard Road Improvement project. Because this project was progressing smoothly and under budget, the City Engineer recommended to the administration in December to have this contractor keep installing new waterline rather than include later on the County contract. The rationale was to maintain our control of the numerous "large" customer accounts in this corridor including the hotels on Walker's Mountain. In addition, our existing waterline and especially the valves were found to be in very poor condition and likely should be replaced at the present and not wait possibly two more years. In accordance with codified ordinance 141.02(a), three (3) members of council need to approve this request before it goes to the Board of Control. 
