Ordinance No. - 2018

An ordinance amending TITLE THREE - TRAFFIC CODE, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton specifically CHAPTER 351 - PARKING GENERALLY, SECTION 351.09 - TRUCK LOADING ZONES, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, to bring relief to those residential property owners residing next to a Light Industrial Zone with frequent loading and unloading of large commercial vehicles, the City wishes to implement reasonable restrictions along the east side of Taft Avenue NE, from East Maple Street to Adena Street NE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That TITLE THREE - TRAFFIC CODE, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton specifically CHAPTER 351 - PARKING GENERALLY, SECTION 351.09 - TRUCK LOADING ZONES, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

351.09 TRUCK LOADING ZONES.

(a) No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle for any purpose or length of time other than for the expeditious unloading and delivery or pickup and loading of materials in any place marked as a truck loading zone during hours when the provisions applicable to such zones are in effect. In no case shall the stop for loading and unloading of materials exceed thirty minutes.

(b) No person shall stop, stand, or park a commercial vehicle for any purpose or length of time in any place along the east side of Taft Avenue NE, from East Maple Street to Adena Street NE, other than for an expeditious left-hand turn from the east to the west side of Taft Avenue NE.

(c) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense; on a second offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree; on each subsequent offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree.

Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to maintain the quality of the City's residential housing districts provide immediate relief to the affected residents; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.

An ordinance amending Chapter 553, Weeds, Trees and Grass, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, specifically, amending Section 553.01, Obstructions on lawn strips and lawn debris in street gutters, by adding subsections (c) and (d) regarding edging and lawn strips, respectively, as described below.

WHEREAS, the interest of public safety, and upkeep of the City's housing stock require residents to maintain their pavement, driveways, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and lawn strips to prevent encroachment from adjacent grassed areas and ground cover, while promoting lawn growth in appropriate areas.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Chapter 553, Weeds, Trees and Grass, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby amended, specifically, amending Section 553.01, Obstructions on lawn strips and lawn debris in street gutters, by adding subsections (c) and (d) regarding edging and lawn strips, respectively, as described below:

(c) In the interest of public safety, all pavement, driveways, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and lawn strips shall be edged when necessary to prevent encroachment from the adjacent grassed areas or ground cover.

(d) Lawn strips shall be maintained in the same manner as lawns and thereby shall contain grass only; lawn strips shall not be filled with mulch, gravel, artificial turf, or other foreign substances used to impede lawn growth.

Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

- Section 1. That Ordinance No. 50-03, Zoning Ordinance of the City of North Canton, and corresponding map, be, and the same is hereby amended to change the zoning of parcels abutting North Main Street and South Main Street, from Orion Street NW and NE to Portage Street NW, to the MSB, as more fully described in Chapters 1121, 1123, 1125, 1127, and 1137 of North Canton's codified ordinances, and excepting those certain parcels not congruent with the intent of the MSB, as clearly illustrated in the Zoning Districts Map attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 3. That any legislation and maps contrary to this ordinance are hereby amended or replaced as needed to implement the ordinance.
- Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

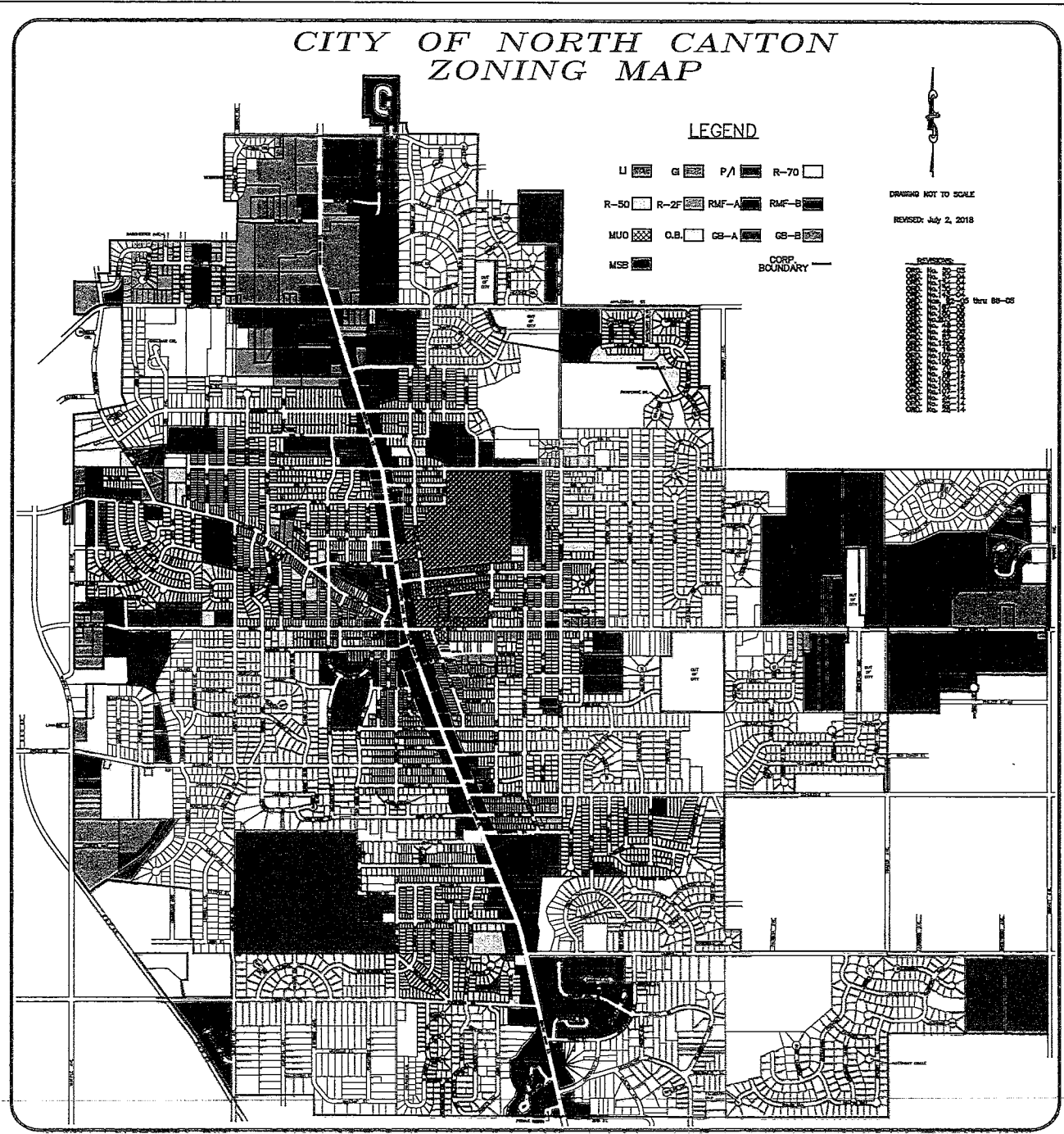
CITY OF NORTH CANTON ZONING MAP

Ordinance No. - 2018

An ordinance amending Chapter 15, Fire Prevention Code, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, specifically, amending Section 1508, Key Lock Box Systems, Subsection 1508.99 Penalty, to realign the City's penalty provision to the Ohio Fire Code as described in Ohio's Administrative and Revised Codes, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety, where access to or within a structure or an area is restricted because of secured openings or where immediate access is necessary for life-saving or fire-fighting purposes, the City's fire code official is authorized to require a key box to be installed in an approved location.

WHEREAS, for consistency reasons, compliance with the City's Key Lock Fire Code provision should be realigned to those described in Ohio's Fire Code as described in Ohio's Administrative and Revised Codes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Chapter 15, Fire Prevention Code, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby amended, specifically, amending Section 1508, Key Lock Box Systems, Subsection 1508.99 Penalty, to read as follows:

Violations of this Chapter shall be enforced according to the provisions of the Ohio Fire Code as described in Ohio's Administrative and Revised Codes.

Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to protect the structures requiring Key Lock Box Systems from unnecessary damage, together with protecting emergency responders from incurring needless injuries and delays that occur in obtaining access to structures without the described systems; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.

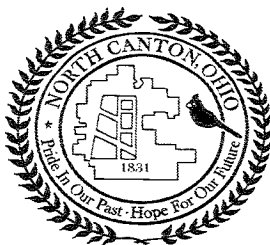

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 73 - 2016, Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") by and between the City of North Canton ("City") and the Utility Workers Union of America, Local 605 (Drinking Water Plant Employees) (the "Union"), to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement") regarding the year 2018 wage reopener described in section 24.01 of the current CBA, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City and the Union entered into a CBA effective November 1, 2016, SERB Case #2014-MED-05-0750; and

WHEREAS, section 24.01 of the CBA provides that "The Parties agree to midterm bargaining for wages only regarding the third year of this Agreement"; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have acknowledged that they did conduct negotiations that resulted in the Agreement, that each had an unlimited right to make demands and proposals regarding wages, and that the understanding and Agreement arrived at by the Parties after the exercise of that right and opportunity are set forth in the Agreement.

WHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 73 - 2016 be, and the same is hereby amended, to reflect the Agreement negotiated between the parties regarding section 24.01 of the current CBA, which shall read as follows:

24.01 Employees assigned to the position descriptions below shall receive a 3% wage increase effective November 1, 2016, a 2% wage increase effective November 1, 2017, and a 3% wage increase effective November 1, 2018.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely wage rate update, together with proper notice to the State Employment Relations Board; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.

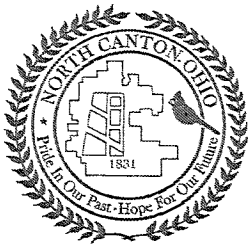
