City Council is responsible for the management and oversight of senior staff for the Department of Finance, the Department of Law, and the Office of City Council. In addition, Council makes several appointments to City boards and commissions.

City Council

Legislative year 2021 was the second session of the 90th Council of North Canton. During the session, Council had no resignations or retirements and therefore made no vacancy appointments. The seven members of Council were as follows:

Ward 1 – Doug Foltz

Councilmember Foltz has served as the Ward 1 Council representative since 1996 making this year his 26th consecutive year of service. Councilmember Foltz is the 3rd longest-serving elected official in North Canton's history and the longest consecutive serving Councilmember. This year Member Foltz was Chairman of the Park and Recreation Committee and Vice Chairman of the Ordinance, Rules, and Claims Committee.

Ward 2 – Daniel “Jeff” Peters

Council Member Peters has served as the Ward 2 Council representative since 2009 making this his 13th consecutive year of service. For legislative year 2021 Councilmember Peters was elected President of Council and served as Chairman of the Personnel and Safety Committee and Vice Chairman of the Street and Alley Committee.

Ward 3 – Stephanie Werren

Councilmember Werren has served as the Ward 3 Council representative since 2012 making this year her 10th consecutive year of service. This year member Werren was Chairwoman of the Finance and Property Committee and Vice Chairwoman of the Park and Recreation Committee.

Ward 4 – Dominic Fonte

Councilmember Fonte has served as the Ward 4 Council representative since 2014 making this year his 8th consecutive year of service. This year member Fonte was Chairman of the Street and Alley Committee and Vice Chairman of the Personnel and Safety Committee.

At Large – Mark Cerreta

Councilmember Cerreta has served as an At-Large Council representative since 2011 making this year his 11th year of service. This year member Cerreta was Chairman of the Water, Sewer, and Rubbish Committee and Vice Chairman of the Community and Economic Development Committee.

At Large – Daryl Revoldt

Councilmember Revoldt has served as an At-Large Council representative since 2018 making this year his 4th consecutive year of service. Having previously served both on Council and as Mayor member Revoldt is the 2nd longest-serving elected official in North Canton history having spent 28 of the past 40 years in office. For legislative year 2021 member Revoldt was elected Vice President of Council and served as Chairman of the Community and Economic Development Committee and Vice Chairman of the Water, Sewer, and Rubbish Committee.
