Ordinance No. 43-10

An ordinance authorizing the supplemental appropriation of funds of the City of North Canton, Ohio, to be appropriated from the unappropriated resources of the Capital Improvement Fund to the Park Department Equipment Account in the amount of \$68,125 for the current expenses during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2010, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the City of North Canton, Ohio, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2010, the following funds, be, and are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Appropriate From:

The unappropriated resources of Fund 330 - Capital Improvement Fund \$68,125

Appropriate To:

330.309.5500 Equipment \$68,125

Section 2. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to issue warrants from appropriations established herein for the payment of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.



That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to fund the Lease Purchase Agreement of the Toro Groundmaster Mower and to ensure the continued efficient operation of the City of North Canton; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
