Ordinance No. 74-10

An ordinance declaring that certain Fire Department equipment owned by the City of North Canton, Ohio, is no longer required for municipal purposes; and, authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to make a donation of said Fire Department equipment; namely, one (1) thermal imager, to Stark State College of Technology Fire/Science Program, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is hereby declared that certain Fire Department equipment; namely, one (1) thermal imager, owned by the City of North Canton is no longer required for municipal purposes, does not exceed \$1,000 in estimated value and was not purchased with grant funds.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, Ohio, be, and is hereby authorized to make a donation of said Fire Department equipment to Stark State College of Technology Fire/Science Program.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely donation of the one (1) thermal imager, to Stark State College of Technology Fire/Science Program; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by council and approval by the Mayor.
