

# Prescription Drug Drop Box Program

Residents can rid themselves of unwanted, unneeded and unused drugs conveniently—anytime—at the North Canton Police Department’s permanently housed drug collection box.

It is located in the downstairs lobby / entrance to City Hall and the police department. It has 24/7 surveillance and is monitored by the police department.

All pharmaceutical drugs in forms of pills, liquids and creams will be accepted. The health board recommends citizens remove labels from containers, or, at minimum, use a Sharpie to blacken out all personal information before the drop-off. Needles and syringes are not accepted. At this time, the Mental Health and Recovery Services Board of Stark County recommended needles and syringes to be placed in a sturdy plastic container (i.e. a laundry detergent or Clorox type bottle), tightly sealed and disposed of in their trash.
