

An ordinance to provide for an election on the adoption of proposed amendment to ARTICLE III - EXECUTIVE AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS AND DEPARTMENTS, Section 3.01. The Mayor, of the Charter of the City of North Canton, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, having determined that applicable statutory requirements as to form, and not substance, have been met, Council of the City of North Canton submits a voter-proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of North Canton, Ohio, and has designated the 5th day of November, 2013, as the date for an election on the adoption of said amendment to the Charter, and;

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Council to make provisions for such election insofar as not prescribed by general law, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO, TWO THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1. That the following ballot language be and is hereby certified as to form, and not substance, to the Stark County Board of Elections for consideration at the general election to be held on November 5, 2013:

The North Canton City Charter
(A Majority Vote is Necessary for Adoption)

Should the proposed amendment to the Charter providing for ARTICLE III EXECUTIVE AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS AND DEPARTMENTS Section 3.01. The Mayor, as it pertains to the Mayor's qualifications powers and duties to state as follows:

The Mayor shall not be otherwise employed by the City and shall hold no other public office than that of Notary Public or member of the Ohio National Guard or Reserve Corps of the United States. The Mayor shall have an office in the administration building of the City and shall be considered a full-time elected official and shall devote his entire time and effort during regular business hours and all other times as are necessary to properly conduct the business of the City.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to meet the filing deadline for the November 5, 2013 General Election ballot; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six (6) or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
