A resolution expressing North Canton City Council's opposition to Issue #13 – Charter Amendment, on the November 5, 2013 General Election ballot, as it pertains to the Mayor's qualifications, powers, and duties.

The Council of the City of North Canton met in regular session on the 14th day of October, 2013, with the following members present: Mark Cerreta, Doug Foltz, Dan Griffith, Marcia Kiesling, Daniel Peters, Jon Snyder, and Stephanie Werren.

Member _____ moved for adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS: A charter review commission, composed of 15 City electors, meets every ten years to review, discuss, and debate proposed amendments to City's Charter; and

WHEREAS: The City's Charter serves as its constitution, by which all other City laws, ordinances, and policies are subservient; and

WHEREAS: The City has enjoyed the Mayor-Administrator-Council form of government since the original City Charter was adopted in 1960; and

WHEREAS: Issue 13 proposes to change the City's form of government with no consideration or concern of how it conflicts with other portions of the Charter and City ordinances currently in place; and

WHEREAS: Issue 13 proposes to drastically decrease the pool of candidates that may qualify to serve as the City's mayor; and

WHEREAS: In the past 20 years, 90% of all North Canton mayoral elections contained only two candidates, and 40% of the time there was only one; and

WHEREAS: Issue 13 proposes that the mayor shall hold no other public office, yet places no similar restriction on any other City official or employee;

WHEREAS: Issue 13 mandates that the mayor shall devote "his entire time and effort during regular business hours," yet, although their duties and responsibilities are described in the Charter, makes no similar requirements upon the members of City Council, the Directors of Administration, Finance, Law, the Clerk of Council, Civil Service Commissioners, members of the Planning Commission, members of the Zoning and Building Standards Board of Appeals, or any other City employees or officials; and

WHEREAS: Although the City's Charter is currently gender neutral, recognizing and celebrating that both men and women are equally qualified to serve the municipality, Issue 13 states that the mayor shall devote "his" entire time effort to conduct the business of the City, thereby-and embarrassingly so—selecting only the

highest level of City government, the mayor, as the proper location with which to place a masculine identifier; and

WHEREAS: Issue 13 was conceived by a committee composed of Chuck Osborne, his wife, Rita Palmer, George Daniluk, Larry Tripp, and Hillary Mueller, with no input from City officials or employees who perform their municipal duties each day in accordance with the Charter's requirements; and

WHEREAS: Because the above-described committee stated that it cut-and-pasted its proposed Charter amendment, straight from the City of Green, Ohio's charter, without amendment, and into North Canton's Charter, it is clear to this City Council that Issue 13 is ill-conceived, haphazardly prepared, unworkable, and certainly not of the form and substance befitting the Charter of the City of North Canton.

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton ("City"), through the Board of Control, to enter into an agreement by and between the City and the North Canton Community Improvement Corporation ("CIC"), to convey to the CIC the real property located in the City and known as parcel numbers 9280699 and 9280795, located at 220 West Maple Street and Harmon Street SW, which the City does not require for its municipal purposes, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the City is the owner of certain real property known as parcel numbers 9280699 and 9280795, located in the City at 220 West Maple Street and Harmon Street SW.
- Section 2. That this Council has determined the City does not require the above-described real property for its municipal purposes.
- Section 3. That this Council has duly designated the CIC as its agent for purposes set forth in R.C. 1724.10.
- Section 4. That the City's Mayor, upon the Board of Control's approval, is authorized to enter into an agreement to transfer ownership of the above-described real property to the CIC.
- Section 5. That the CIC is hereby authorized to market and sell or lease the above-described property for uses determined by the City as those that will promote the welfare of the people of the City, stabilize the economy, provide employment, and assist in the development of industrial, commercial, distribution and research activities to the benefit of the people of the City, and will provide additional opportunities for their gainful employment upon such terms and upon such consideration as the City may specify.
- Section 6. That said or lease or sale shall be conditioned upon the City's prior approval of terms and consideration as presented by the CIC.
- Section 7. That upon the City's approval, the CIC is hereby authorized to execute a lease or a quit-claim deed of conveyance therefor to the lessee or buyer, and to execute such other instruments as are necessary for the completion of certain transactions.
- Section 8. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 9. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City North Canton, and further necessary for the timely transfer of the above-described and currently vacant real property, in further consideration of rapidly changing economic conditions and circumstances, and to promote the welfare of the people of the City, stabilize the economy, provide employment, and assist in the development of industrial, commercial, distribution and research activities to the benefit of the people of the City; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six (6) or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.

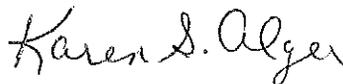

Section 4. That this ordinance is necessary for the to ensure the timely payment of the 1% Residential and 3% Commercial state fees. Wherefore, it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
