Ordinance No. 68-07

An ordinance to provide for an election on the adoption of proposed amendment to ARTICLE III, Section 3.01(5) of the Charter of the City of North Canton.

WHEREAS, Council of the City of North Canton recommends and submits a draft of an amendment to the Charter of the City of North Canton, Ohio, and has designated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2007, as the date for an election on the adoption of said amendment to the Charter, and;

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Council to make provisions for such election insofar as not prescribed by general law, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO, TWO THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1. That the following ballot language be and is hereby certified to the Stark County Board of Elections for consideration at the general election to be held on November 6, 2007:

(A Majority Vote is Necessary for Adoption)

The proposed amendment to the Charter providing for Article III, Section 3.01(5), as it pertains to the Mayor's executive powers and duties by the removal of the words "and by the courts for the purpose of serving civil processes", to state as follows:

The Mayor shall be recognized as the official and ceremonial head of Government by the Governor for military purposes.
