Ordinance No. 54-11

An ordinance authorizing the Akron-Canton Regional Airport Waterline Extension, located in the Southeast portion of the Akron-Canton Airport property, in Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the North Canton City Engineer, and accepting any necessary easement associated with said waterline extension, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Administration of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to extend the Akron-Canton Regional Airport Waterline Extension, located in the Southeast portion of the Akron-Canton Airport property, approximately 1640 +/- feet, in Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the North Canton City Engineer, and accepting any necessary easements associated with said water main extension.
- Section 2. That payment of the full cost of said water main extension shall be the responsibility of the applicant-developer.
- Section 3. That pursuant to Section 925.01(e) of the Codified Ordinances, Council hereby authorizes the extension of the aforementioned waterline located outside the corporate limits of the City of North Canton.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:
