As you are aware, a substantial flooding event took place on July 19, 2011. Approximately five to seven inches of rain fell within a few hours in North Canton as well as surrounding areas. Due to the rains the City has roughly 70 homes that were affected in a detrimental manner.

I am requesting that permit fees are waived or reimbursed through our Permits and Inspection Department for installation of new equipment, such as water heaters or furnace/air conditioners, etc. due to the flooding.

An ordinance authorizing the Superintendent of Permits and Inspection to waive or reimburse permit fees for replacement of hot water tanks; air conditioners; furnaces; or electrical work, directly related to flood damage, for the period from July 20, 2011 through and including October 31, 2011, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Superintendent of Permits and Inspection, be, and is hereby authorized to waive or reimburse permit fees for replacement of hot water tanks; air conditioners; furnaces; or electrical work, directly related to flood damage, for the period from July 20, 2011 through and including October 31, 2011.
- Section 2. That, prior to providing such a waiver or reimbursement the Superintendent of Permits and Inspection shall investigate and verify the applicable work directly resulted from flood damage. Such investigation may include, among other things, a site visit; interviews with the contractor and homeowners; review of photographs; and/or review of invoices.
- Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to ensure the timely waiving or reimbursement of permit fees for residents affected by the flood damage; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six (6) or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


I am writing in regards to the flooding that accord on July 19th, 2011 that filled our basement with 3 to 4 feet of water as well as our backyard. This flooding is a direct result of the lack of storm water drainage on the city owned Fairway's Golf Course located behind us. The water came through a crawl space located on the back of our house that comes from an over filled pond on the course that lacks the proper drainage. The water that fills the pond is provided from a 12inch pipe that collects rain water and other drainage located near Orchard Hill School just a few blocks away.

This flooding problem has been acknowledged by city officials since 2003. We had a total of over \$5,000.00 dollars in damage to our basement with the loss of many items to include but not limited to: power tools, dehumidifier, two computers, refrigerator, furnace, and washer and holiday items. Today I am submitting my receipts for the furnace repair totaling \$1317.44, washer replacement totaling: \$1152.66, dehumidifier \$218.00, three fans to cool house while furnace was not working: \$47.56, one trailer full of lost items to Kimble transfer: \$32.10. The total for the entire reimbursement is: \$2767.76.

The city of North Canton is responsible for the replacement of these items due to the lack of proper storm water drainage from city property and the reallocation of funds to resolve these drainage problems.







- Section 1. That the Administration of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to extend the Shuffel Drive NW (Frank Avenue easterly 300 feet) Waterline, located in Jackson Township, Stark County, Ohio, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the North Canton City Engineer, and accepting any necessary easements associated with said water main extension.
- Section 2. That payment of the full cost of said water main extension shall be the responsibility of the applicant-developer.
- Section 3. That pursuant to Section 925.01(e) of the Codified Ordinances, Council hereby authorizes the extension of the aforementioned waterline located outside the corporate limits of the City of North Canton.

- Section 5. That the engineer for the developer shall be required to certify that the design of the water main extension will supply the required flows and pressures for the intended purpose at this extension.

- Section 4. As you are aware, Stark State and the Timken Company have teamed to construct a new Wind Energy R&D Center to be located at the northeast corner of Frank Rd. and Shuffle Dr. The water needs for the project will be supplied from a connection to the existing 12-inch ductile iron water line running along the west side of Frank Rd.

An 8-inch ductile iron water line will be extended from the existing 8-inch tap and valve stubbed from the 12-inch line at the corner of Frank and Shuffle. The proposed line will travel east along Shuffle to the proposed entrance to the new R&D facility where it will turn north to serve the new building. A portion of this waterline will be installed in the public right of way along Shuffle and will fall under the City ordinance 935.01, which, in part, states that the waterline must be extended to the end of the property line for future service connections. In this case the additional waterline proposed to be installed beyond the building's service connection is approximately 700 feet. In addition, the only current potential user for this extension is the State highway Patrol barracks on Hossler Dr. Please see the enclosed exhibit.

The 700 foot length of unused waterline becomes problematical in that the water in this portion of the line is not circulating and can stagnate, lose its chlorine residual and become capable of supporting bacterial growth. This growth can eventually make its way back into the active portion of the water system. A valve separating the active portion of the waterline from the unused length is possible and will keep water out of the unused portion for a time but if the valve fails it would again lead to an unsafe situation. In addition the valve will become non-functional in a short period of time requiring replacement if the line were to be extended in the future.

The proposed solution to this issue is to allow Stark State to place a plug on the eastern leg of the tee separating the public and private portions of the waterline. If and when the situation arose to extend the waterline to the east Stark State would extend the line at no cost to the City. This would prevent a potentially harmful condition for the staff and students at the proposed Stark State Timken facility and supply the waterline extension at a later date if needed.

WATERLINE PLAN AND PROFILE



