Ordinance No. 95-11

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor, Director of Administration and Personnel & Safety Committee of North Canton City Council to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of North Canton and The Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (OPBA) (Patrolmen), and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor, Director of Administration and Personnel & Safety Committee of North Canton City Council, be, and are hereby authorized to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of North Canton and The Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (OPBA) (Patrolmen).

Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.


Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary and further necessary for the timely effectiveness of the Collective Bargaining Agreement; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six (6) or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
