CALL TO ORDER:

The Public hearing was called to order Monday, January 9, 2012 at 6:48 p.m. by President of Council Jon Snyder.

ROLL CALL:

Council Members present for the public hearing: Council Members Cerreta, Fox, Foltz, Griffith, Kiesling, and Snyder. Mr. Peters was absent from the public hearing. Also present were: Mayor Held, Director of Administration Grimes, Director of Administrative Services Bartos, Finance Director Alger, Director of Law Nilges was not present for the public hearing.

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the City of North Canton on Monday, January 9, 2012 at 6:45 p.m. in the Council Chamber at North Canton City Hall. The hearing is with regard to a request to vacate a portion of Alley #12 approximately 145 feet north of West Maple Street and parallel therewith, beginning at the east side of Mohler Court N.W. and running easterly for approximately 156 feet to Part Lot #23, and located within the corporate limits of the City of North Canton. Final action thereon will be taken by the Council of the City of North Canton subsequent to the public hearing.

Mr. Snyder: The Public Hearing is pursuant to call on Alley #12, which is vacation of said on part of out lot 23 and located between the corporate limits and the City of North Canton. Is there anybody in the audience wishing to speak in opposition to the vacation of the alley? Anyone in the audience wishing to speak in favor of the vacation of the alley? Any member of Council?

Mrs. Kiesling: She raised her hand.

Mr. Snyder: Oh, I beg your pardon, ma'am. I apologize. Please step forward and state your name and address for the record. Right there at the microphone. Thank you.

Ms. East: My name is Tina East and I am the treasurer for Northminster Presbyterian Church so I am here on behalf of the church, and I just wanted to explain that the reason we're asking for this partial vacation of the alley is for safety reasons. When we have an activity that involves children so we're using the property that we purchased that abuts Portage Street. That's a green space and we use that for games and for picnics and so forth, and right now we can't set up sawhorses or anything because it's a public alley so there's a lot of cars going up and down and we just are worried about the safety of the kids.

Mr. Snyder: Any questions of Council in relationship to the vacation of the alley? Mr. Fox, as chairman of the Street & Alley, have you any questions?

Mr. Fox: No, I have no questions. I visited the property yesterday. I went to take a quick look at it. I know the Planning Commission has reviewed this itself as a public hearing and approved it 5-0. I recommend approval.

Mr. Snyder: Mr. Administrator, any questions?

Mr. Grimes: Just so they don't build a fence 12 foot high – that's the way I walk to work. (Laughter)

Mr. Snyder: There being no other, I'll entertain a motion to adjourn this public hearing.

Mrs. Kiesling: So moved.


Mr. Foltz: Second.
