## Ordinance No. 100-12

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to prepare and submit applications for the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Stark County Community Development Block Grant Program ("CDBG Program") for a grant for the Hillcrest Avenue NW and Royer Avenue NW Waterline Replacement Project (5<sup>th</sup> Street NW to 7<sup>th</sup> Street NW) and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Stark County Commissioners participates in the federal CDBG Program of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to make application to the CDBG Program for the Hillcrest Avenue NW and Royer Avenue NW Waterline Replacement Project (5<sup>th</sup> Street NW to 7<sup>th</sup> Street NW) to be funded under the CDBG's Program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to prepare and submit applications for the CDBG Program for a grant for the Hillcrest Avenue NW and Royer Avenue NW Waterline Replacement Project (5<sup>th</sup> Street NW to 7<sup>th</sup> Street NW).

Section 2. That, if any provision of this Ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary in order to meet the deadline for submission of applications for the CDBG Program for a grant for the Hillcrest Avenue NW and Royer Avenue NW Waterline Replacement Project (5<sup>th</sup> Street NW to 7<sup>th</sup> Street NW); wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six (6) or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
