
Ordinance No. 3-12

An ordinance approving, confirming and accepting a Perpetual Public Sanitary Sewer Easement Agreement, located in Sections 7NE and 6SE, being part of Out Lot 276, and known as Parcel No. 9207868, situated in the City of North Canton, from David T. Boettler, necessary for the completion of the North Main Street Reconstruction – Phase VI Project, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:


- Section 1. That a Perpetual Sanitary Sewer Easement Agreement, located in Sections 7NE and 6SE, being part of Out Lot 276, and known as Parcel No. 9207868, situated in the City of North Canton, from David T. Boettler, necessary for the completion of the North Main Street Reconstruction – Phase VI Project, be, and the same is hereby approved, confirmed and accepted.
- Section 2. That David T. Boettler grants to the City a perpetual easement, including but not limited to, the right to lay, re-lay, construction, install, maintain, operate, alter, inspect, repair, remove, replace and renew at will an eight inch (8") sanitary sewer main with the right of ingress and egress at any time to and from such utility and all appurtenances thereto on, under and through said property.
- Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely approval, confirmation and acceptance of the this Easement Agreement; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six (6) or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
