### Ordinance No. 34-12

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration and for the Mayor of the City of North Canton to be authorized, through the Board of Control, to enter into an Agreement for the purchase and installation of a Dump Bed, Hydraulics, Salt Box, Plow and Light Package on a new Two and a Half (2.5) Ton International Cab and Chassis Truck, for use by the Street Department, from a vendor or, in the alternative, pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement for the purchase and installation of a Dump Bed, Hydraulics, Salt Box, Plow and Light Package on a new Two and a Half (2.5) Ton International Cab and Chassis Truck, for use by the Street Department, within the purview of the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act.

Section 2. In the event a purchase through the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act is not feasible in the discretion of the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton, that the Director of Administration, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Office of the Director of Administration and for the Mayor, to be authorized, through the Board of Control, to enter into an Agreement for the purchase and installation of a Dump Bed, Hydraulics, Salt Box, Plow and Light Package on a new Two and a Half (2.5) Ton International Cab and Chassis Truck, for use by the Street Department.

Section 3. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, be, and is hereby authorized to purchase a Dump Bed, Hydraulics, Salt Box, Plow and Light Package on a new Two and a Half (2.5) Ton International Cab and Chassis Truck, for use by the Street Department, from a vendor if they are at a lower price than state bid contract and if they are at equivalent terms, conditions, and specifications as authorized by Ohio Revised Code 125.04.

Section 4. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified agreement from the following appropriation:

upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

Section 5. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.


