
Ordinance No. 40-12

An ordinance declaring that certain Fire Department equipment owned by the City of North Canton, Ohio, is no longer required for municipal purposes and authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to sell said Fire Department equipment; namely, three (3) Lifepak Defibrillators for Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) to the Paris Township Fire Department, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That it is hereby declared that certain Fire Department equipment; namely, three (3) Lifepak Defibrillators owned by the City of North Canton is no longer required for municipal purposes.
- Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, Ohio, be, and is hereby authorized to sell said Fire Department equipment for Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) to the Paris Township Fire Department.
- Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely sale of this equipment and to be able to meet the Paris Township Fire Department's immediate needs for such equipment; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
