Ordinance No. 53-12

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to prepare and submit an application to the Federal Highway Administration ("FHWA") through the Stark County Area Transportation Study ("SCATS") for a grant for the West Maple Street Widening Project (from North Main Street to Ream Avenue NW); and, authorizing the Mayor, through the Board of Control, to enter into an agreement for said grant, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to prepare and submit an application to the FHWA through SCATS for a grant for the West Maple Street Widening Project (from North Main Street to Ream Avenue NW).
- Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for said grant.
- Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary in order to meet the deadline for the submission of applications for the West Maple Street Widening Project; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six (6) or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
