Ordinance No. 4-13


An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton ("Mayor") to submit a Participation Agreement and request authority for the City of North Canton to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's ("ODOT") contract for the purchase of sodium chloride (rock salt) for the 2013-2014 winter season, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01(B) of the Ohio Revised Code permits any political subdivision to participate in contracts which ODOT's director has entered for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies, or other articles.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:


- Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit and request authority for the City of North Canton to participate in ODOT's contract for the purchase of sodium chloride (rock salt) for the 2013-2014 winter season.
- Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the City of North Canton to be bound by all terms and conditions as ODOT's director prescribes.
- Section 3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the City of North Canton to directly pay vendors, under each such ODOT contract in which the City of North Canton participates.
- Section 4. That the City of North Canton agrees to be responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the cooperative purchasing program under Section 5513.01(B) of the Ohio Revised Code. The City of North Canton releases and forever discharges ODOT and its director from all such claims, actions, expenses, or other damages arising out of its participation in the cooperative purchase program which the City of North Canton may have or claim to have against ODOT or its employees, unless such liability is the result of negligence on the part of ODOT or its employees.
- Section 5. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 6. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, Ohio and further necessary to meet the submission deadline of the application for the 2013-2014 season; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
