BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. The Council of the City of North Canton, Ohio hereby rejects the Fact Finding Report dated October 20, 2014, regarding the City of North Canton, Ohio, Employer, and Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Union, Case No. 2014-MED-03-0456, by Fact Finder Jonathan I Klein.
