BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That That the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration for the purchase of a replacement liner for the Dogwood Swimming Pool.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a replacement liner for the Dogwood Swimming Pool, at a cost not to exceed \$240,000.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified agreement from the following appropriation:

## Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue

The County Auditor of Stark County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:

1. On May 6, 2014, the taxing authority of the Council of the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio certified a copy of its Resolution No. 38-14 adopted May 5, 2014, requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by one (1.0) mills, to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation for storm water sewer improvements, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19(O), 5705.191 and 5705.25, to be placed on the ballot at the November 4, 2014, election. The levy type is renewal.
2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$354,227
3. The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$354,410,510.


