Resolution No. 57-14

A resolution of submission of question of a renewal of a tax levy for the purpose of providing funds for the City's portion of storm water sewer improvements in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton, upon due investigation and consideration, has determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation in and for the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for the next five (5) years is insufficient to fund the City's portion of storm water sewer improvements in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the facts above set forth, Council has determined that it should, and hereby does, declare itself to submit to the electors of the City of North Canton at the General Election to be held on November 4, 2014, the questions of a renewal tax of one (1.0) mill outside the ten (10) mill limitation for the purpose of providing funds for the City's portion of storm water sewer improvements in the City of North Canton for a period not to exceed five (5) years, tax years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019, said renewal levy to be at a rate not exceeding one (1.0) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten (10) cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be submitted to the electors of said subdivision at the General Election on November 4, 2014, the question of a renewal tax levy outside the ten (10) mill limitation in and for said subdivision in the amount of one (1.0) mill, for the purpose of providing funds for the City's portion of storm water sewer improvements in the City of North Canton; and that said additional one (1.0) mill shall be levied for five years, tax years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the submission of said proposal, the notice of election, the form of ballot, the certificate of the levy as voted outside the ten (10) mill limitation, and the levying of such additional millage shall be in accordance with the provisions of R. C. 5705.19, 5705.191 and 5705.25 and other related sections of the Ohio Revised Code, in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the form of the ballot case at such election shall be:

(A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage)

"A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for the purpose of providing funds for the City's portion of storm water sewer improvements in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, at a rate not exceeding one (1.0) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten (10) cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years: tax years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019."

Resolution No. 58-14

A resolution of submission of question of a renewal of a tax levy for the purpose of providing funds for the City's portion of street improvements in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton, upon due investigation and consideration, has determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation in and for the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for the next five (5) years is insufficient to fund the City's portion of street improvements in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the facts above set forth, Council has determined that it should, and hereby does, declare itself to submit to the electors of the City of North Canton at the General Election to be held on November 4, 2014, the questions of a renewal tax of one (1.0) mill outside the ten (10) mill limitation for the purpose of providing funds for the City's portion of street improvements in the City of North Canton for a period not to exceed five (5) years, tax years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019, said renewal levy to be at a rate not exceeding one (1.0) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten (10) cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation.

Ordinance No. 59-14

An ordinance amending CHAPTER 553 - WEEDS, TREES, AND GRASS, specifically section 553.01 SHRUBBERY AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS PROHIBITED ON LAWN STRIPS, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton to include the prohibition of placing lawn clippings and other lawn debris on public streets, sidewalks, curbs, or gutters, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That CHAPTER 553 - WEEDS, TREES, AND GRASS, specifically 553.01 SHRUBBERY AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS PROHIBITED ON LAWN STRIPS of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 553 - Weeds, Trees, and Grass.

553.01 OBSTRUCTIONS ON LAWN STRIPS AND LAWN DEBRIS IN STREET GUTTERS

(a) No person shall plant, allow to be planted, or upon notification fail to promptly remove any trees, flowers, shrubbery, or other similar obstructions within the limits of any dedicated streets of the City, or upon the portion of any of such streets known as the lawn strips, between the sidewalk and roadway.

(b) No person shall place or allow to be placed grass clippings, shrub and tree trimmings, leaves, limbs, or a yard waste of any kind ("lawn debris") on any public street, sidewalk, curb, or gutter within the City or to allow lawn debris to sit on private property for such period of time or in such a manner as to cause the lawn debris to gain access by natural means onto public streets, sidewalks, curbs, or gutters within the City, or fail to promptly remove the lawn debris upon notification.

Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City North Canton and further necessary to protect the City's storm water sewer system from blockage and resultant flooding; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.

Ordinance No. 60-14

An ordinance authorizing the supplemental appropriation of funds of the City of North Canton, Ohio, to be appropriated from the unappropriated resources of the Permit Fee Fund to the State Building Permit Fee Account in the amount of \$2,000.00 for the current expenses during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2014, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the City of North Canton, Ohio, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2014, the following funds, be, and are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Appropriate From:

The unappropriated resources of the 871 Fund - PERMIT FEE FUND	\$ 2,000.00
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Appropriate To:

871 PERMIT FEE FUND	
871.627.5200 State Building Permit Fees	\$2,000.00

Section 2. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to issue warrants from appropriations established herein for the payment of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, and further necessary recharge the depleted State Building Permit Fees account so that the City experiences no delay in its ability to provide local building permits for residential and commercial building projects; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

RE: Supplemental Appropriation Request

I am requesting that Council consider legislation appropriating funds in the amount of **\$2,000 for the Permit Fee Fund for payment relating to the required 1% Residential and 3% Commercial state fees.** I am requesting a supplemental appropriation as follows:

- \$2,000 from the Unappropriated Resources of the Permit Fee Fund to A/C 871.627.5200. (State Building Permit Fees).

Permits have exceeded expectation on the number of permits pulled for projects within the City, therefore, we request an increase in appropriation to pay the State their portion by law the permit fees collected.

I would request that the legislation be passed on an emergency basis in order to have the funding in place as soon as possible to make payments.
