Ordinance No. 13 - 2015

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, and pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, to enter into an agreement with Ohio CAT for the purchase of a CAT 430FIT backhoe/loader, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton must replace a backhoe/loader; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act enables municipalities, such as the City of North Canton, to benefit from economies of scale, expedite its procurement process, and achieve a substantial purchase savings for the purchase of a CAT 430FIT backhoe/loader.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, and pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Ohio CAT for the purchase of a 2015 CAT 430FIT backhoe/loader at a cost not to exceed \$119,227.

Section 2. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above-specified contract from the following appropriations:

upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.


Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely purchase of a 2015 CAT 430FIT backhoe/loader before the spring/summer work season begins for City employees involved in service projects for City residents and guests such as street, water, storm and sanitary sewer projects; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
