Ordinance No. 39 – 2015

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration, and authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a contract for the Canton-Akron Airport Water System Improvement Project, at a total cost not to exceed \$75,000, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, CAK Airport Water System requires an upgrade; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a contract for the Canton-Akron Airport Water System Improvement Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration, for the Canton-Akron Airport Water System Improvement Project.

Section 2. That the Mayor of City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the Canton-Akron Airport Water System Improvement Project, at a total cost not to exceed \$75,000.


Section 3. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified contract from the following appropriation:


upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

Section 4. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely completion of the Canton-Akron Airport Water System Improvement Project; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
