Ordinance No. 44 - 2015

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to enter into an amendment to the support agreement between the City of North Canton and Stark County Park District (Stark Parks) to participate and provide the City's share of the amendment to the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton desires to enter into an amendment to the support agreement of the HMGP; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:


- Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton is hereby authorized to enter into an amendment to the support agreement between the City and Stark Parks to participate and provide the City's share in the HMGP. The City's share is \$12,900. Stark Parks is the recipient and manager of the grant.
- Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, and with other participating agencies awaiting the City's approval, time is of essence to move forward with the mitigation process before the winter season impedes progress; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
