Ordinance No. 55 - 2015

An ordinance authorizing the waterline extension for St. James Place No. 13, located in part of the S.E. Quarter of Section 32, Lake Township, Range 8, Stark County, Ohio, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the North Canton City Engineer, and accepting any necessary easements associated with said waterline extension, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, St. James Place No. 13 requires a waterline extension; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:


- Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to extend a waterline to St. James Place No. 13, located in part of the S.E. Quarter of Section 32, Lake Township, Range 8, Stark County, Ohio, in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the North Canton City Engineer, and accepting any necessary easements associated with said waterline extension.
- Section 2. That payment of the full cost of said waterline extension shall be the responsibility of the applicant-developer.
- Section 3. That pursuant to Section 925.01 of the Codified Ordinances, Council hereby authorized the extension of the aforementioned waterline located outside the corporate limits of the City of North Canton.
- Section 4. That said waterline extension shall be pursuant to Section 935.08, Nonresident's Use of Water or Sanitary Sewer Service agreement of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton.
- Section 5. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above-specified cost upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper department authority from appropriations applicable thereto.
- Section 6. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, and further necessary for the timely approval so that the City may continue to provide potable water to its residents and complete the extension during favorable weather conditions; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
