- Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

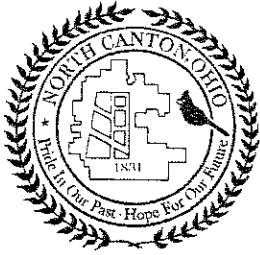
