Resolution No. 36-14

A Resolution of North Canton City Council authorizing the Stark County Regional Planning Commission ("Commission") to submit a loan application on behalf of the City of North Canton ("City") to the Local Government Innovation Fund ("LGIF") for the purchase of a permitting software system for use by the City's Building and Engineering Department, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, a feasibility study of shared building department services between Stark County and its cities was completed utilizing grant monies from the LGIF with the intent to increase efficiency and coordinate future planning among building departments; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined from the study that the current permitting software, where it exists, should be replaced with a permitting software system that can be managed on a regional basis while maintaining jurisdictional autonomy with respect to finances, permit issuance, permit numbering and individual reporting mechanism; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has submitted an application for a loan of \$200,000 to the LGIF that will cover costs for permitting software and implementation on behalf of Stark County its cities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That North Canton City Council does hereby authorize the Commission to submit a loan application on behalf of the City of North Canton to the LGIF for the purchase of a permitting software system for use by the City's Building and Engineering Departments.
- Section 2. That if a provision of this resolution is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 5. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to meet the May 6, 2014 deadline for review of the Local Government Innovation Fund loan application; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six (6) or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
