Ordinance No. 71 – 2015

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton upon concurrence of Council, through the Board of Control, to enter into a contract for administering a self-insured health insurance program for the period of December 1, 2015 through November 30, 2016, for the employees of the City of North Canton, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, and upon concurrence by Council, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for administering a self-insured health insurance program for the period of December 1, 2015 through November 30, 2016, for the employees of the City of North Canton.
- Section 2. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above-specified contract upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by proper departmental authority from appropriations applicable thereto.
- Section 3. That, if any provision of this Ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this Ordinance.
- Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, and safety of the City of North Canton and further necessary for timely renewal of the City employees' health insurance policy; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
