
Ordinance No. 17 - 2017

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids, and authorizing the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, to enter into a two-year contract for the cleaning of the Sludge Lagoons at the North Canton Drinking Water Treatment Plant, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:


- Section 1. That the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office for the cleaning of the Sludge Lagoons, and upon Board of Control approval, the Mayor is authorized to enter into a two-year contract for the project.
- Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, upon Board of Control approval, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a two-year contract for the cleaning of the Sludge Lagoons at the North Canton Drinking Water Treatment Plant.
- Section 3. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified contract upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority from appropriations applicable thereto.
- Section 4. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to ensure the continued and efficient operation of the North Canton Drinking Water Treatment Plant by having Sludge Lagoons cleaned as soon as the weather permits; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
