Ordinance No. 20 - 2017

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, upon Board of Control approval, and pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, to enter into an agreement with Southeastern Equipment Co., for the purchase of a 2017 CASE 590SN backhoe with the trade in of the City's 2009 CASE 590SM, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton must replace a backhoe; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act enables municipalities, such as the City of North Canton, to benefit from economies of scale, expedite its procurement process, and achieve a substantial purchase savings for the purchase of a 2017 CASE 590SN backhoe with the trade in of the City's 2009 CASE 590SM.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, upon Board of Control approval, and pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Southeastern Equipment Co., for the purchase of a 2017 CASE 590SN backhoe at a cost not to exceed \$53,680.60. The total cost of the 2017 CASE 590SN originally was \$108,680.60, with the trade in price of \$55,000.00 given for the 2009 CASE 590SM, the final cost will not exceed \$53,680.60.

Section 2. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above-specified contract from the following appropriations:

upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely purchase of a 2017 CASE 590SN backhoe with the trade in of the 2009 CASE 590SM before the spring/summer work season begins for City employees involved in service projects for City residents and guests such as street, water, storm and sanitary sewer projects; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and


approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
