Ordinance No. 4 - 2017

An ordinance appointing a 2017 Charter Review Commission composed of fifteen electors of the City of North Canton, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 6.04 of the Charter of the municipality of North Canton, Ohio, states:

"In January, 1967 and in January of each tenth year thereafter, the Council shall appoint a commission of fifteen electors of the municipality who hold no other municipal elective or appointive office, except on advisory bodies of the municipality, as members of a Charter Review Commission. Such commission shall review the Municipal Charter, and within five calendar months after such appointment, recommend to Council such alterations, revisions and amendments, if any, to this Charter, as in judgment of the Charter Review Commission are desirable. The Council shall cause the recommendations of the Charter Review Commission to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality on two successive weeks, and Council shall hold a public hearing on such recommendations within one week after the second publication thereof. Meetings of the Charter Review Commission shall be public meetings;" and

WHEREAS, the following fifteen electors of the City of North Canton, Ohio, will serve on the 2017 Charter Review Commission:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the North Canton City Council will officially appoint fifteen individuals to serve as the Charter Review Commission for 2017.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to allow for the timely appointments due to the time constraint in which the Charter Review Commission has to make their recommendations; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected

thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.


