Ordinance No. 8 - 2017

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, and authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, upon Board of Control approval, to enter into a contract for the 2017 Sanitary Sewers Rehab Project, at a cost not to exceed \$400,000, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, certain City sanitary sewers require replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a contract for the 2017 Sanitary Sewers Rehab Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office for the 2017 Sanitary Sewers Rehab Project.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, upon Board of Control approval, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the 2017 Sanitary Sewers Rehab Project, at a cost not to exceed \$400,000.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified contract from the following appropriations:

upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

Section 4. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely bidding process and to enter into a contract in order for the 2017 Sanitary Sewers Rehab Program to begin in a timely manner; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


