WHEREAS, North Canton City Council recommends and submits a draft amendment to the City's Charter and has designated the 7th day of November, 2017, as the date for an election on the adoption of said amendment to the Charter, and;

WHEREAS, Council has the duty to make provisions for such election insofar as those not prescribed by general law; now therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO, TWO THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1. That the following ballot language be and is hereby certified to the Stark County Board of Elections for consideration at the general election to be held on November 7, 2017:

**PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT
CITY OF NORTH CANTON**

A Majority Vote is Necessary for Adoption.

The proposed amendment to the Charter Article VI, Section 6.04, Charter Review, to add the sentence "by the majority vote of the commission members." to read as follows:

In January, 1967, and in January of each tenth year thereafter, the Council shall appoint a commission of 15 electors of the municipality who hold no other municipal elective or appointive office, except on advisory bodies of the municipality, as members of a Charter Review Commission. The commission shall appoint a chairperson, vice chairperson, and a secretary. Such commission shall review the Municipal Charter, and within five calendar months after such appointment, recommend to Council such alterations, revisions, and amendments, if any, to this Charter, as in the judgment of the Charter Review Commission are desirable **by the majority vote of the commission members**. The Council shall cause the recommendations of the Charter Review Commission to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality on two successive

weeks, and Council shall hold a public hearing on such recommendations within one week after the second publication thereof. Meetings of the Charter Review Commission shall be public meetings.

A resolution on submission of request to the Stark County Auditor, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03(B), to certify to the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, as the City's taxing authority, the City's total current tax valuation, as a subdivision, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated for a renewal tax of 1.5 mills, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19, 5705.191 and 5705.25 for the purpose of providing ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both, in the City for a period of five years, tax years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021, commencing 2017, first due in calendar year 2018, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

WHEREAS, upon due investigation and consideration, the Council of the City of North Canton has determined that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation in and for the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements for said City for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both, in the City of North Canton, for a period of five years, tax years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018.

WHEREAS, by reason thereof, this Council has determined that it will be necessary to tax 1.5 mills, which is in excess of such limitation, for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both, in the City of North Canton, for a period of five years, tax years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03(B), this Council is required to certify to the Stark County Auditor, a resolution requesting the Auditor certify to Council the City's total current tax valuation as a subdivision, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills. In addition, Council is required to state the purpose of the tax, whether the tax is an additional levy or a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax and identify the section of the Ohio Revised Code authorizing submission of the question of the tax to the Stark County Board of Elections for determination as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Council of the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, on behalf of City of North Canton and as taxing authority for said City, does hereby

determine that it is necessary to levy a tax, outside the ten 10-mill limitation for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both, in the City of North Canton, for a period of five years, tax years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018.

- Section 2. That Council, pursuant to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03(B), does hereby certify to the Stark County Auditor this resolution requesting the Auditor the City's total current tax valuation as a subdivision, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a renewal tax of 1.5 mills, for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both, in the City of North Canton, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19(U), 5705.191 and 5705.25 authorizing submission of the question of the renewal of an existing tax at the November 7, 2017 general election.
- Section 3. That the Clerk of Council, be, and is hereby directed and authorized to certify this resolution to the Stark County Auditor pursuant to the provisions of Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, and to proceed with all things necessary to be done in order to accomplish the purpose of this resolution and the requirements of Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 4. That if a provision of this resolution is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 5. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to timely submit the question on the ballot for the November 7, 2017 general election; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Resolution No. 8 - 2017

A resolution of submission of question of a renewal of a tax levy for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both, in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton upon due investigation and consideration has determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation in and for the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for the next five years, will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both, in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the facts above set forth, Council has determined should, and hereby declares it shall submit to the electors of the City of North Canton for the November 7, 2017 general election, the question of replacing a tax of 1.5 mills outside the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of providing ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both, in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for a period not to exceed five years, tax years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021, and that said renewal levy shall be at rate not to exceed 1.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 15 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That there shall be submitted to the electors of said subdivision for the November 7, 2017 general election, the question of renewal tax levy outside the 10-mill limitation in and for said subdivision in the amount of 1.5 mills, for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of providing ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both, in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, and that said additional 1.5 mills shall be levied for five years: 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021.
- Section 2. That the submission of said proposal, the notice of election, the form of ballot, the certificate of the levy as voted outside the 10-mill limitation, and the levying of such additional millage shall be in accordance with the provisions of Sections 5705.19, 5705.191, 5705.25, and other relevant sections of the Ohio Revised Code, in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided; and

Section 3. That the form of the ballot cast at such election shall be:

(A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage)

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for the purpose of providing additional funds for the City's portion of providing ambulance service, emergency medical service or both, in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to 15 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing with tax year 2017, first due in calendar year 2018.

Section 4. That the Clerk of Council, be, and is hereby directed and authorized to proceed forthwith with the certification hereof to the Board of Elections of Stark County, Ohio, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 5705.19, 5705.191 and 5705.25, and other relevant sections of the Ohio Revised Code, and to proceed with all things necessary to be done in order to accomplish the purpose of this resolution.

Section 5. That if a provision of this resolution is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this resolution.

Section 6. That this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
