Ordinance No. 70 - 2017

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, and authorizing the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, to enter into an agreement for the purchase of two radio consoles with supporting console radio equipment from a vendor, or, in the alternative, pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton must replace two radio consoles with supporting console radio equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act enables municipalities, such as the City of North Canton, to benefit from economies of scale, expedite its procurement process, and achieve a substantial purchase savings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Administration is authorized to advertise and receive bids for the purchase two radio consoles with supporting console radio equipment, according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, either from a vendor, or, in the alternative, pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, at a cost not to exceed \$122,583.00.

Section 2. That the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval is authorized to enter into an agreement for the purchase of two radio consoles with supporting console radio equipment from a vendor, or, in the alternative, pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, at a cost not to exceed \$122,583.00.


Section 3. That the Director of Finance, upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority, is authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above-described contract from the following appropriation.:

Section 4. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.


Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and after the earliest period allowed by law.
