Ordinance No. 74 - 2017

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, and authorizing the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, to enter into a contract for the purchase and installation of an emergency generator for City Hall from a vendor or pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, and declaring the same to be an emergency.


WHEREAS, to maintain critical city equipment and services during power outages, City Hall requires a new emergency generator; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to advertise, receive competitive bids, and enter into a contract from a vendor or pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act for the purchase and installation of an emergency generator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Director of Administration, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office for the purchase and installation of an emergency generator from a vendor or pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act.
- Section 2. That the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase and installation of an emergency generator at City Hall.
- Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely bidding process and to enter into a contract for the purchase an installation of an emergency generator at City Hall to maintain critical city equipment and services during power outages; provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
