Ordinance No. 81 - 2017

An ordinance establishing rental rates and policies for the rental of City owned facilities or portions thereof, located within the municipal corporation limits of the City of North Canton, Ohio, repealing Ordinances 21-08, 47-10, 19-11, 31-13, and 45-16, and any and all legislation inconsistent herewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Administration is hereby authorized to develop, implement, and maintain administrative policies, guidelines, and fees governing the rental of City-owned buildings, facilities, parks, sports fields, and portions thereof, Said administrative policies and guidelines shall include, but not be limited to, preserving and protecting City-owned facilities available for rent; providing for the fair and orderly reservation and usage of facilities; and promoting access for City residents, guests, businesses, schools, and community organizations.

Section 2. That City-owned buildings, facilities, parks, sports fields, and portions thereof held for rental may require additional maintenance and other administrative fees, subject to change, as determined by the Director of Administration, which are not included in the Daily Rental Rates.

Section 3. That the Daily Rental Rates for City owner buildings, facilities, parks, sports fields, and portions thereof shall be as follows:

Civic Center Gazebo, in conjunction with Events Hall rental, includes the use of up to 50 outdoor chairs.

Section 4. That there be, and is hereby established, for the rental of the North Canton Civic Center Events Hall, a contract rate discount of 10% off the Daily Rental Rates for three or more reservations in a rolling 12 month period from the date of the initial contract.

That there be, and is hereby established, for the rental of the North Canton Civic Center Events Hall and the North Canton Dogwood Park Pavilion, a contract discount rate of 5% off the Daily Rental Rates for residents of the City of North Canton.

Section 5. That there be, and is hereby established, an advance damage security deposit for the Events Hall of the Civic Center in the amount of \$400.00. The advance deposit does not reflect the maximum amount to which a lessee may be held responsible.

Section 6. That the Director of Finance is authorized to set aside up to 10% of the effective daily rental rate on every facility use agreement for future capital improvements of the above facilities.

Section 7. That at any event at the North Canton Civic Center Events Hall where alcoholic beverages are to be provided, the lessee shall, in advance, pay to the City the cost of providing security services for a period of four hours. Should security be required for more than four hours, additional hourly rates will apply.

Section 8. That there be, and is hereby established, the following Refund Policy for a reservation cancellation:

Picnic Shelters, Sports Fields, Offices, Portico, Council Chambers:  
NONREFUNDABLE

Civic Center, Dogwood Pavilion: 180 or more days prior to event: FULL REFUND

90-179 days prior to event: 50% REFUND

89 days or less: NO REFUND

Section 9. That rental rates of Sports Fields for purposes of all practices shall be restricted to a four hour permitted use.

Section 10. That this ordinance shall not apply to leagues for Sports Fields that have paid any applicable league fee required by the North Canton Department of Recreation.

Section 11. That games of chance shall be permitted only at the North Canton Dogwood Park Pavilion and the North Canton Civic Center, providing the Lessee complies with the laws of the State of Ohio and the City of North Canton.

- Section 12. That there be, and is hereby established procedures whereby governmental and school entities shall have the option of leasing the North Canton Civic Center through use of a purchase order.
- Section 13. That Ordinance Nos. 21-08, 47-10, 19-11, 31-13, and 45-16, and any and all legislation previously passed and inconsistent herewith, be, and the same are hereby repealed.
- Section 14. That said rental rates shall be for facility use agreements executed after the effective date of this ordinance.
- Section 15. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 16. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 1. That Chapter 155 Personnel Regulations of Part One, Administrative Code, specifically, COMPENSATION, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Ordinance No. 83 - 2017

An ordinance amending CHAPTER 135, DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE, specifically Section 135 Personnel, Subsections 135.03(a) and (b), of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton, to increase the maximum limit of full-time Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedics from no more than six, to no more than eight, repealing any and all legislation inconsistent herewith, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City desires to decrease the amount of overtime hours necessary to provide live-saving services to City residents and guests, together with reducing unnecessary additional costs for emergency services.

WHEREAS, increasing the maximum limit of full-time Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedics from no more than six, to no more than eight, will further the City's goal of decreasing the amount of overtime hours necessary to provide live-saving services to City residents and guests, together with reducing unnecessary additional costs for emergency services

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That CHAPTER 135, DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE, specifically Section 135 Personnel, Subsections (a) and (b), of the Codified Ordinance of the City of North Canton, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 135.03 Personnel

(a) The Fire and Emergency Medical Service Department shall be comprised of the following ranks and positions: One full-time Chief of Fire and Emergency Medical Service Department; no more than three full-time Firefighter/EMT/Fire Inspectors; no more than three full-time Captains—Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedics; no more than **eight** full-time Emergency Medical Technician Paramedics; together with those part-time volunteer personnel, as required, and that shall be designated by the Director of Administration.

(b) Effective January 1, 2005, if a full-time Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic position becomes vacant, it shall be replaced with a full-time Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic/Firefighter. At no time will there be more than **eight** full-time Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic/Firefighters.

- Section 2. That any and all legislation inconsistent herewith, be, and is hereby repealed.
- Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a consent agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purpose of rehabilitating the Easthill Street bridge over the West Branch Nimishillen Creek.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, upon Board of Control approval, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a consent agreement by and between the City and ODOT for the rehabilitation of the bridge on Easthill Street SE over the West Branch Nimishillen Creek (SFN 7670907), known as the Project PID No. 99798 - STA-Culverts- FY2018. This would replace Ordinance No. 32-2014.
- Section 2. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified cooperation agreement from the applicable appropriation upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.
- Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, Ohio, and further necessary for the timely execution of the consent agreement between the City and ODOT, which will expedite the bridge rehabilitation project scheduled for 2018; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

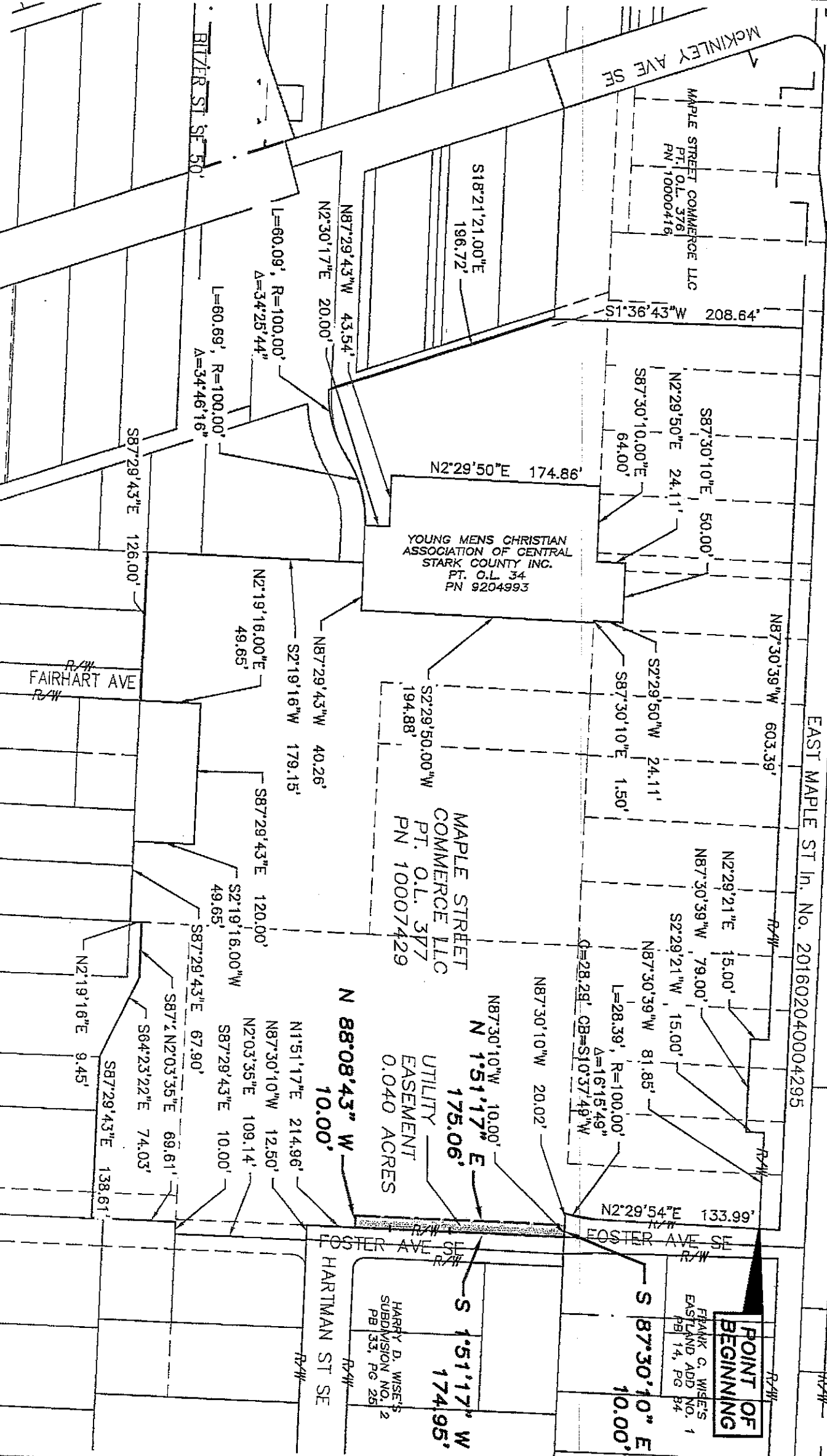
