Resolution No. 1 - 2018


A resolution rejecting the Fact Finding Report dated January 18, 2018, regarding the City of North Canton, Ohio, Employer, and Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Dispatch and Lead Dispatcher's Union, State Employment Relations Board ("SERB") Case No. 2017-MED-10-1312, by Fact Finder Thomas Nowel, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to rule 4117-9-05, Fact-finding, of the Ohio Administrative Code, the employer's legislative body shall meet and vote to accept or reject the recommendations of the fact finder, and within 24 hours after the vote, shall serve SERB and the employee organization's exclusive representative by electronic mail, verification of the date of the vote, the vote tally, and the number of members of the legislative body.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the City of North Canton, Ohio hereby rejects the Fact Finding Report dated January 18, 2018, regarding the City of North Canton, Ohio, Employer, and Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Dispatch and Lead Dispatcher's Union, Case No. 2017-MED-10-1312, by Fact Finder Thomas Nowel.
- Section 2. That if a provision of this resolution is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this resolution.
- Section 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely rejection of the Fact Finding Report dated January 18, 2018, as required by the State Employment Relations Board; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


