RESOLUTION 19 - 2023

A resolution for the submission of the question of a replacement and increase tax levy for the purpose of providing for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges under ORC sections 5705.19(G) and 5705.191, in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton upon due investigation and consideration has determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation in and for the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for the next five years, pursuant to the provisions of Section 5705.02 of the Ohio Revised Code, will be insufficient to provide adequate funding for the purpose of providing for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges under ORC sections 5705.19(G) and 5705.191, in the City of North Canton; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the facts above set forth, Council has determined it should, and hereby declares it shall, submit to the electors of the City of North Canton for the May 2, 2023 election, the question of a replacement of one (1) mill of an existing levy and an increase of one (1) mill outside the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of providing for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges under ORC sections 5705.19(G) and 5705.191, in the City of North Canton, for a period not to exceed five years, being calendar years 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026, and 2027 commencing 2023 first due in calendar year 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That there shall be submitted to the electors of the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for the May 2, 2023 election, the question of a replacement and increase tax levy outside the 10-mill limitation in and for said subdivision in the amount of two (2) mills, for the purpose of providing for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges under ORC sections 5705.19(G) and 5705.191, in the City of North Canton, and that said replacement and increase two (2) mills shall be levied for five years, being calendar years 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026, and 2027.

Section 2. That the form of the ballot cast at such election shall be:

(A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.)

A replacement of one (1) mill of an existing levy and an increase of one (1) mill, to constitute a tax for the benefit of North Canton for the purpose of providing for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges, that the county auditor estimates will collect \$ 1,025,045 annually, at a rate not exceeding two (2) mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$70 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for five (5) years.

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council, be, and is hereby, directed and authorized to proceed forthwith with the certification hereof to the Board of Elections of Stark County, Ohio, pursuant to the provisions of section 5705.19(G), 5705.191 and other relevant sections of the Ohio Revised Code, and to proceed with all things necessary to be done in order to accomplish the purpose of this resolution.

Section 4. That if a provision of this resolution is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 5. That this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

A resolution for the submission of the question of a replacement and increase tax levy for the purpose of providing for flood defense, providing and maintaining a flood wall or pumps, and other storm water improvement purposes to prevent floods in said City under ORC sections 5705.19(O) and 5705.191, in the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton upon due investigation and consideration has determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation in and for the City of North Canton, Stark County, Ohio, for the next five years, pursuant to the provisions of Section 5705.02 of the Ohio Revised Code, will be insufficient to provide adequate funding for the purpose of providing for flood defense, providing and maintaining a flood wall or pumps, and other storm water improvement purposes to prevent floods under ORC sections 5705.19(O) and 5705.191, in the City of North Canton; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the facts above set forth, Council has determined it should, and hereby declares it shall, submit to the electors of the City of North Canton for the May 2, 2023 election, the question of replacement of one (1) mill of an existing levy and an increase of one (1) mill outside the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of providing for flood defense, providing and maintaining a flood wall or pumps, and other storm water improvement purposes to prevent floods under ORC sections 5705.19(O), in the City of North Canton, for a period not to exceed five years, being calendar years 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026, and 2027 commencing 2023 first due in calendar year 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1.
