**DESCRIPTION:** See the attached application.

Planning voted at their meeting on October 4, 2023, to approve the amendment as presented.

The City Council must set a public hearing to consider this item. However, the closest meeting date more than 30 days from October 23, 2023, is Monday, November 27, 2023. This date currently does not have a scheduled meeting of this Council and it also does not allow time for three readings prior to term change. The Clerk of Council therefore recommends the Council hold the legislation in the Community and Economic Development Committee but have the hearing on November 27, 2023, at 6:45 PM. The Council may then postpone further consideration until the next Council is seated. That Council may then decide to advance the legislation out of committee. If the legislation is recommended out of Committee and is not resolved by the end of the current Council term (November 30, 2023)

the legislation will die and must be resubmitted. (See Roberts Rules of Order Newly Revised 12 Ed. Section 9:8 on page 81.)

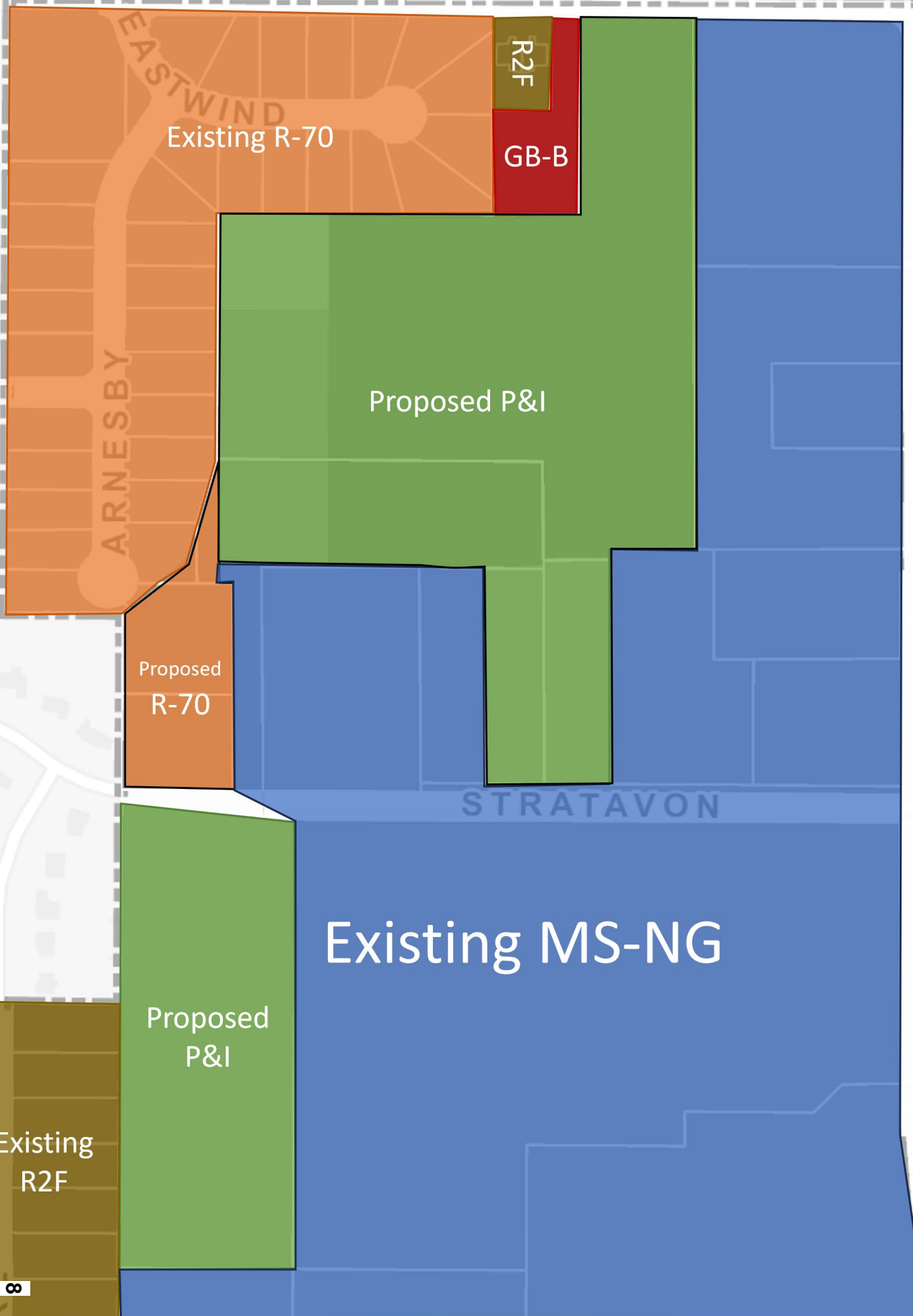

ORDINANCE 69 - 2023

An ordinance amending the zoning map of the City of North Canton to reclassify 10 parcels in the City of North Canton, in accordance with the amendment procedure set forth in Chapter 1182 of the Planning and Zoning Code, from their existing classifications to Park and Institutional (P&I) or Residential Single Family Large Lot (R-70).

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton wishes to create a new park in the North Gateway District; and

WHEREAS, the City's acquisition of property for the park has resulted in some small and/or isolated residential properties, the zoning for which does not match the surrounding neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Office of City Council, on July 7, 2023, received a completed and approved Application for Zoning Amendment for the above-described zoning change from the Office of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public meeting for the purpose of gaining public input on the proposed zoning change on October 4, 2023, pursuant to Section 1182.04 of the North Canton Codified Ordinances, and recommended that City Council adopted the legislation as submitted; and

WHEREAS, City Council held a public meeting for the purpose of gaining public input on the proposed zoning change on \_\_\_\_\_, pursuant to Section 1182.06 of the North Canton Codified Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the zoning map of the City of North Canton be, and is hereby, amended to reclassify 10 parcels in the northwestern corner of the City, in accordance with the amendment procedure set forth in Chapter 1182 of the Planning and Zoning Code as follows and as illustrated in the map attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit A".

- a. The classification of the premises known as being Out Lots 325, 445, and 330, Lot 6742, and Part of Out Lot 192 (Stark County Parcels 9209052, 10017004, 9209047, 9209048, and 10002818) shall be reclassified from Main Street North Gateway (MS-NG) to Park and Institutional (P&I).
- b. The classification of the premises known as being Lots 7235, 7234, 7228, 7006, and 7007 (Stark County Parcels 10017006, 10017005, 10016626, 9209421, and 9209422) shall be reclassified from Residential Two-Family (R2F) to Residential Single Family Large Lot (R-70).

Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

WHEREAS, this Council in accordance with the provisions of law has previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, The Budget Commission of Stark County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to this Council together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and what part within the ten mill limitation.
