**DESCRIPTION:** In the interest of providing the most efficient City governance

possible it may be pertinent to explore the possibility of amendments

to specific provisions of the City Charter which may be overly cumbersome or could be improved for the benefit of the City. The Ordinance and Rules Committee is seeking discussion on how

Council might undertake the project of considering these issues and crafting the best possible alternatives, if appropriate, to be put to the

electors.

Potential points for amendment include:

- 1. Amendments to Charter Sections 3.03 and 3.06 to more accurately reflect the departmental organization structure utilized by the City.
- 2. Amendments to Charter Section 2.05 paragraph 7 and/or 3.05 to more easily allow the Director of Finance to make year-end appropriations necessary to balance the City's budget at the end of

each fiscal year.

3. Amendments to Charter Section 2.05 to specify clearer differences between resolutions and ordinances of City Council.
