NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given that:

Recent, and temporary amended sessions of Ohio's Revised Code, specifically R.C. 121.22 Public meeting - exceptions, together with orders and directives from the Ohio Attorney General and the Ohio Department of Health, as well as the safety directives from the President and Center for Disease Control regarding health risks posed by COVID-19, compel the City of North Canton to take unprecedented actions to continue the business of government while limiting gatherings so as to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Accordingly, in this limited circumstance, where the Governor has declared a state of emergency and the Director of the Ohio Department of Health is limiting gatherings to prevent the spread of COVID-19, the City shall hold its public meetings via teleconference; all other requirements of Ohio's Open Meetings Act, R.C. 121.22, shall be fulfilled.

Meeting notices shall provide instructions for the public on how they may hear discussions and deliberations of all members of the public body, and in certain circumstances, address the public body themselves.

The City of North Canton shall hold the **Special Council Meeting on March 5, 2021 at 12:00 PM** via teleconference. See attached agenda for matters to be discussed.

RESOLUTION ## - 2021

A resolution joining, affirming, adopting, and ratifying the City's response to the February 8, 2021 Letter from Woda Cooper Development, Inc. concerning the proposed development of property located at 300 Waterside Drive SE, North Canton, OH 44720.

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton received a letter dated February 8, 2021 from Woda Cooper Development, Inc. ("Woda Letter") concerning the proposed development of property located at 300 Waterside Drive SE, North Canton, OH 44720 ("Real Estate"); and

WHEREAS, the Real Estate is subject to the terms and conditions of a prior economic incentive agreement ("Waterside Agreement") by and between the property owner and the City, which provided that the property owner would market the Real Estate and create 120 new jobs for the City relating to businesses located on the Real Estate, in exchange for the City investing \$275,000 of municipal, non-grant funds for the construction of Waterside Drive and infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, the proposed development of the Real Estate as outlined in the Woda Letter is inconsistent with the terms and conditions of the Waterside Agreement and the significant public investment in the Real Estate; and

WHEREAS, the City has drafted a response to the Woda Letter, detailing its concerns and objections to the proposed development of the Real Estate; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to join, affirm, adopt, and ratify the City's response to the Woda Letter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. The members of Council affirmatively join, affirm, adopt, and ratify the City's proposed response letter to the Woda Letter relaying the City's objection to the proposed development of the Property.
- Section 2. That if a provision of this resolution is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this resolution.
- Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, peace, morals and general welfare of the City of North Canton; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force upon its adoption by Council, together with the Mayor's approval. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
