Ordinance No. 20 - 2019

An ordinance authorizing the appropriation of \$250,000.00 of the City of North Canton funds, from the unappropriated resources of the Capital Improvement Fund, to Contract Payments Fund, for the purchase, and installation of a generator, capable of providing electricity for the complete operation of all departments in City Hall in the event of a power outage.

WHEREAS, to provide prompt routine and critical emergency services to residents and guests, North Canton City Hall departments require an emergency generator for uninterrupted electricity for lighting, electronics, elevator, heating, cooling, etc.; and


WHEREAS, recent events, such as the weather-related loss of power at City Hall on February 25, 2019, demonstrate an emergency exists in providing uninterrupted electrical power to support City emergency and non-emergency services; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is necessary to transfer the funds to purchase and install the emergency generator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That to provide for the purchase and installation of a City Hall emergency generator, \$250,000.00 of the City of North Canton funds shall be appropriated from the unappropriated resources of the Capital Improvement Fund, to the Contract Payments account, 330.627.5229.
- Section 2. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to issue warrants from appropriations established herein for the payment of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.
- Section 3. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
