Ordinance No. 34 - 2019

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, and authorizing the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, to enter into a contract for the Glenwood Street SW Waterline Replacement Project, in an amount not exceed \$850,000.00, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, Glenwood Street SW requires a waterline replacement to reliably provide potable water to residents and guests; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to advertise, receive bids, and enter into a contract for replacing the waterline on Glenwood Street SW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, for the Glenwood Street SW Waterline Replacement Project.

Section 2. That the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for replacing Glenwood Street SW waterline, as described above in an amount not exceed \$850,000.00.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified contract from the following appropriation:

651.767.5502 Facilities/Inside Water	\$850,000.00
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upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

Section 4. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.


Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for a timely bidding and contract process in order for the Glenwood Street SW waterline replacement project to begin in weather-permitting conditions; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
