Ordinance No. 14 - 2020

An ordinance authorizing the appropriation of funds of the City of North Canton to be appropriated from the unappropriated resources of the General Fund and the Insurance Fund, for current expenses during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to promptly appropriate additional funds into the various budget lines within the 2020 budget to cover additional City expenses for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the City of North Canton, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020, the following funds, be, and are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

TOTAL SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS \$3,456,000

Section 2. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to issue warrants from appropriations established herein for the payment of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

- Section 3. That the Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized to transfer \$220,750 from the Income Tax Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund for debt service due as related to the 2020 Safety Center Bonds.
- Section 4. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to promptly appropriate additional funds into the various budget lines within the 2020 budget to cover additional City expenses for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law
