

ORDINANCE NO. 9-79

An ordinance amending Section 2. of Ordinance No. 56-78, adopted by the North Canton City Council May 23, 1978, by the establishment of the job classification title of full-time Recreation Director of the City of North Canton at the rate of compensation of \$13,500.00 per year, effective the pay period beginning January 14, 1979, and declaring it to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2. of Ordinance No. 56-78, adopted by the North Canton City Council May 23, 1978, be, and is hereby amended by the establishment of the job classification title of full-time Recreation Director of the City of North Canton at the rate of compensation of \$13,500.00 per year, effective the pay period beginning January 14, 1979, to read as follows:

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, Ohio, and necessary for the timely establishment of a job classification title and rate of compensation in order to enable the efficient operation of the Recreation Department of the City of North Canton, and shall take effect and be in force upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
