

ORDINANCE NO. 43-79

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, Ohio, through the Board of Control, to enter into a contract for the rebuilding of the water pump and the replacement of the 1,000 gallon water reservoir of the 1970 Sewer Jet equipment owned by the City of North Canton without advertisement and competitive bidding at a price not to exceed \$7,650.00, and declaring it to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Council hereby finds that an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Storm and Sanitary Sewer Department of the City of North Canton in the maintenance of the sewers and that it is immediately necessary to enter into a contract for aforesaid rebuilding of the 1970 Sewer Jet.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the rebuilding of the water pump and the replacement of the 1,000 gallon water reservoir of the 1970 Sewer Jet equipment owned by the City of North Canton at a price not to exceed \$7,650.00.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and he is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified contract from the following appropriation:

30-611 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Dept.
A/C 30-611-24 Maintenance of Equipment
\$7,650.00

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, Ohio, and immediately necessary for the efficient maintenance of the sewers of the City of North Canton, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
