


ORDINANCE NO. 47-79

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a contract for the sale of one (1) Life-Pak 4 Unit without advertisement and competitive bidding, and declaring it to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:


- Section 1. That it be hereby declared that the Life-Pak 4 unit owned by the City of North Canton, Ohio, is no longer needed for any municipal purpose.
- Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the sale of one (1) Life-Pak 4 unit.
- Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and immediately necessary in order to authorize the timely sale of said Life-Pak 4 Unit to the Village of Waynesburg and using the proceeds of said sale for the purchase of a Life-Pak 5 Unit for the Emergency Medical Services Department, which is vitally needed by said Department, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon adoption by the Mayor.
