ORDINANCE NO. 68-79

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, Ohio, through the Board of Control, to enter into a contract for the purchase of one (1) Life Pak 5 without advertisement and competitive bidding, at a price not to exceed \$5,355.00, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. Council hereby finds that an emergency exists in the usual operation of the Emergency Medical Services Department of the City of North Canton, in the medical assistance in an emergency situation, and that it is immediately necessary to enter into a contract for aforesaid Life Pak 5.
- Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, be, and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one (1) Life Pak 5 without advertisement and competitive bidding, at a price not to exceed \$5,355.00.
- Section 3. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, Ohio, be, and he is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified contract from the applicable appropriations upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.
- Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, Ohio, and immediately necessary in order to purchase a demonstrator model of the Life Pak 5 and realize a savings of \$595.00, and shall take effect and be in force upon its adoption and approval of the Mayor.


