

ORDINANCE NO. 115-79

An ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 72-79, adopted by the Council of the City of North Canton June 11, 1979, declaring Out Lot No. 164 and Lot No. 3734 situated in the City of North Canton and owned by the City of North Canton, are no longer needed for any municipal purpose and authorizing the Board of Control, through the Director of Administration, to advertise and receive bids for the sale of the premises per the specifications prepared by the City Engineer:

WHEREAS, the Council has held public hearings and had meetings with residents of the area in respect to the disposal of Out Lot No. 164 and Lot No. 3734 in the City of North Canton as no longer needed for municipal purposes and;



WHEREAS, the Council has determined that there are possible uses of the premises for municipal purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. 
Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
